- A strong understanding of the five core financial literacy topics: Assets, Banking, Budgeting, Consumerism and Credit
- Training in facilitation skills, adult learning principles and best practices in working with people with barriers to financial inclusion
- The license to facilitate and distribute the Momentum Financial Literacy Curriculum
